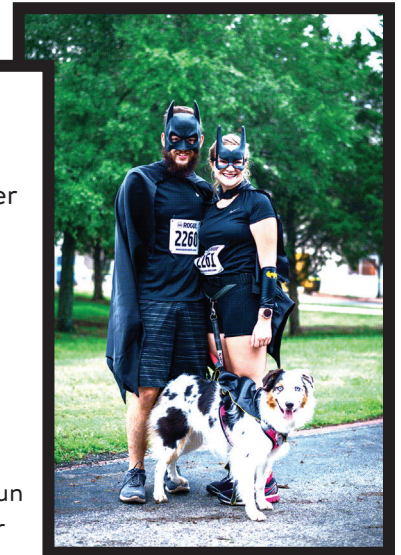
WHAT'S THE MISSION?

The fun of the CASA Superhero Run shouldn't just be the race. Plan fun activities for your team. Have a costume building party, a fundraising competition or train for the run together!



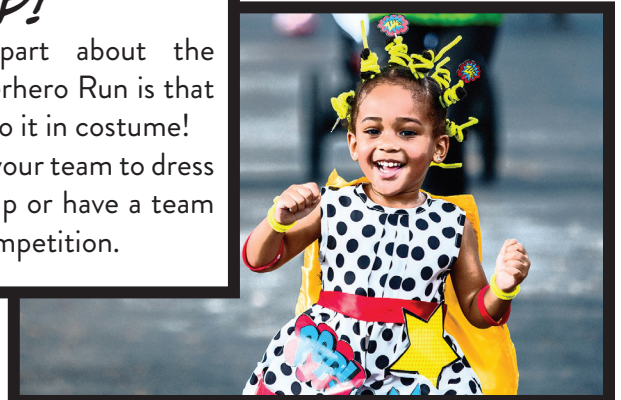
SET A SQUAD GOAL

Having something to strive for helps to build team excitement. Setting and reaching a fundraising goal together will strengthen your team while making a difference for kids!




SLIT UP!
